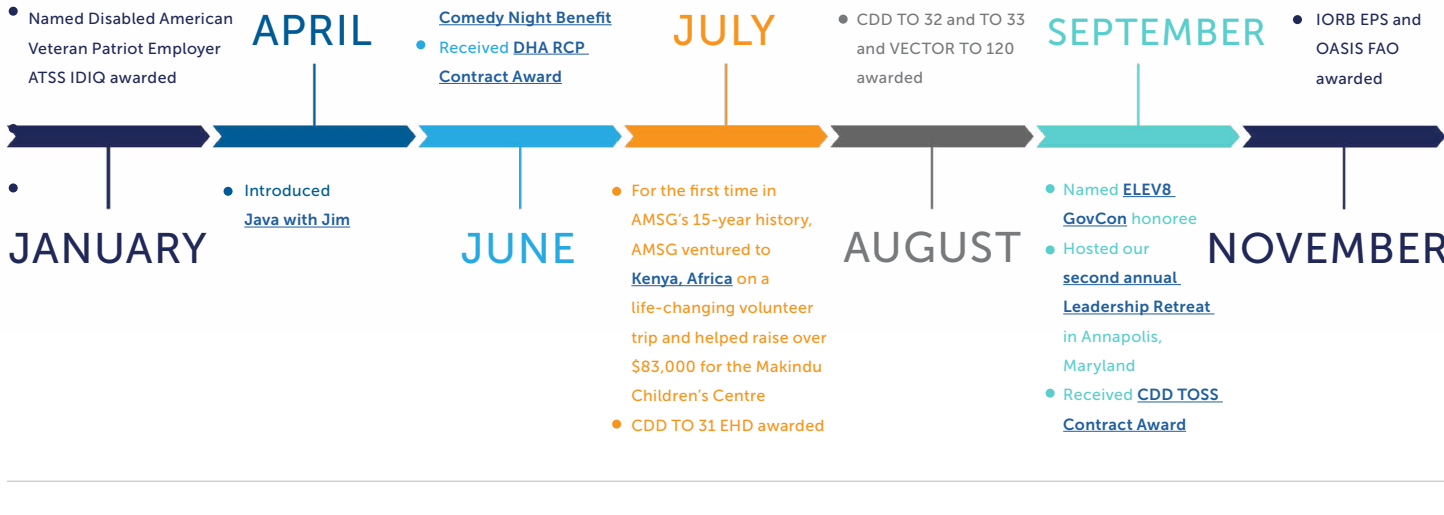
About AMSG

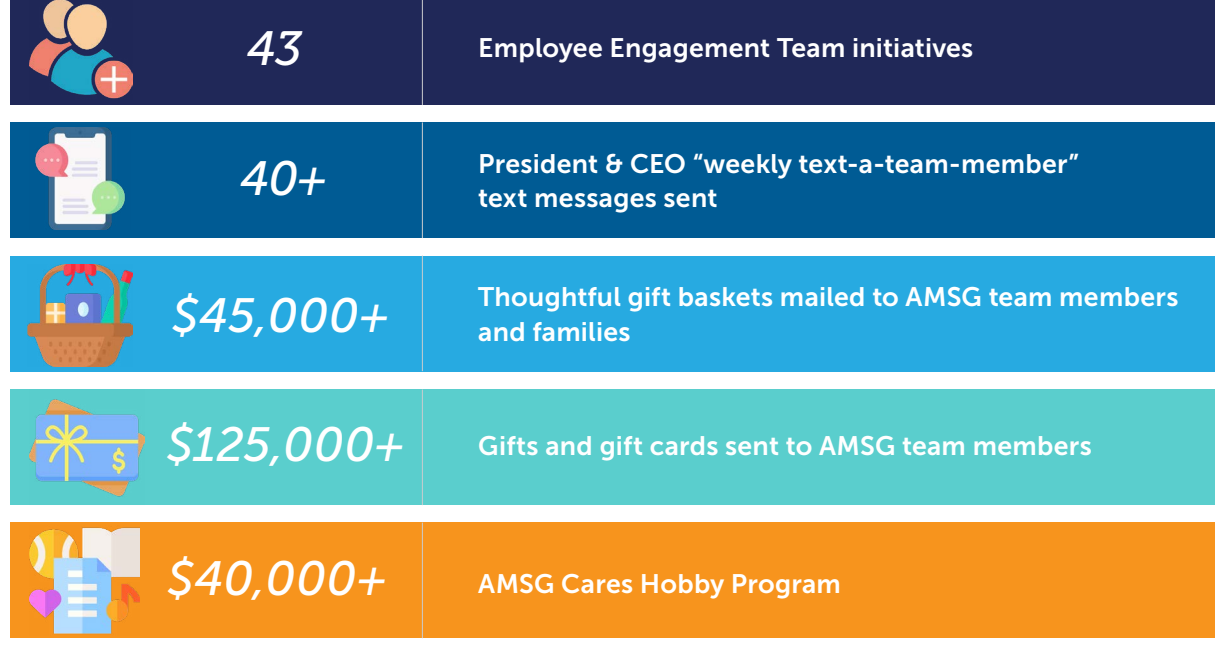
Highlights of 2023

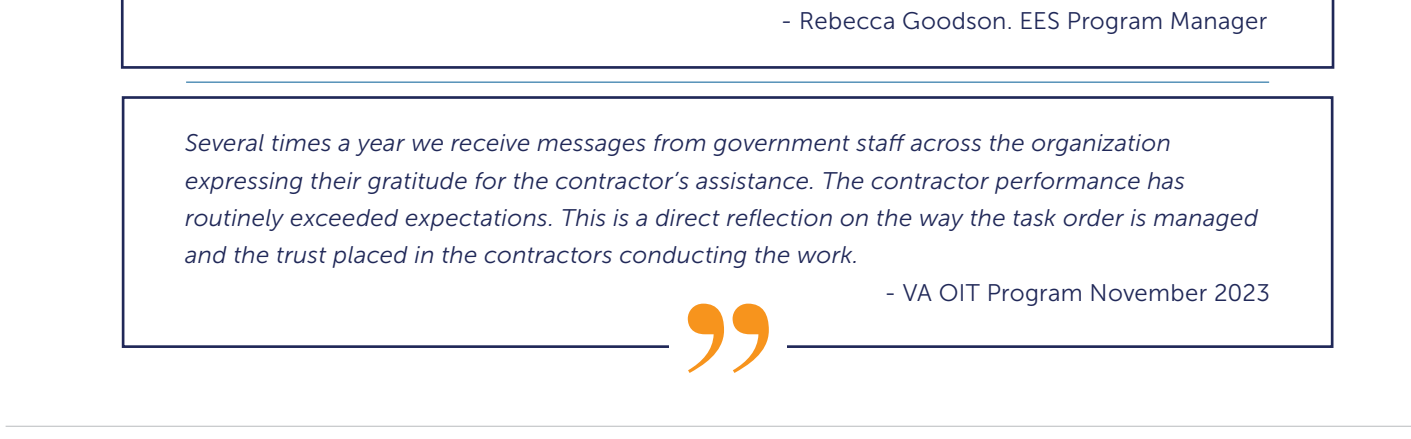
