1. DHS OAW STAFFING

When DHS awarded AMSG the Operation Allies Welcome (OAW) contract to support the resettlement of thousands of vulnerable Afghans, our team staffed over 100 extremely niche positions very rapidly. Our around-the-clock dedication resulted in a quick project start-up, minimizing transition time.

2. VA ORGANIZATION TRANSFORMATION


